

Scottish Veterans Residences is a charity established in 1910 to support former members of the Armed Forces of all ages who are homeless, isolated or in need.

We provide high quality accommodation with dedicated support at our residences in Edinburgh, Dundee and Glasgow. Each residence is a Registered Housing Support Service regulated by the Care Inspectorate. The support service is delivered by qualified staff and includes:

- income maximisation and assistance with welfare benefits
- accessing leisure time and social activities
- linking in to community networks and services and volunteering in the local community
- signposting to specialist services such as alcohol, drug services or counselling
- move into mainstream housing where appropriate
- specialist employment mentors to assist with accessing education, training and employment opportunities
- counselling from qualified therapists

In addition there are numerous groups and activities that take place such as gardening, fitness training, football, bowling, fishing and days out.

Our services are available to anyone who has served in HM Forces, Reserve Forces or Merchant Marine, regardless of age or length of service.
